#### **Summary**



**Parliaments** are the cornerstone of democracy in Europe. They ensure the political representation of citizens.

Work of parliaments can be followed through textual transcripts of parliamentary proceedings.

Upstream project ParlaMint

- FAIR availability of proceedings of 29 European parliaments
- unified encoding and comparable metadata
- linguistic corpora intended primarily for language research

**ParlaCAP's mission** is to open this dataset for political scientists and other researchers that rely on tabular data rather than on textual collections.



**CLARIN ERIC** flagship project (2020-2023)


26 national and 3 regional parliaments

8 million speeches, 1.2 billion words

29 languages

Linguistically annotated, translated into English

Rich speaker and party metadata





Most scientific disciplines lack the ability to work with more than a billion words of text in 29 different languages

"Text as data" paradigm

 each speech represented through variables of topic discussed and sentiment expressed

Recent improvements in natural language processing - high-accuracy automatic multilingual text classification

**Linguistic corpus** through CLARIN.SI, part of CLARIN ERIC

**Tabular dataset** through CROSSDA, part of CESSDA ERIC

Access to subsets of the 8-million-speeches dataset through an **API and web interface** 

Dissemination and training events to ensure data uptake



### **Scientific Impact**



Comparative parliamentary studies of **political agenda-setting** across European parliaments

Unprecedented insight in the distribution of **political focus** across the 26 nations and its dependence on

- state of democracy
- position on the political spectrum
- expression of sentiment
