Final Deliverables process for OSCARS-funded projects

Step 1: The PI and the project team need to provide within 30 days after the end of the project:

- A final public summary of the project in PDF format of maximum 2000 characters, including spaces (*template is available at this [link](#)*);
- A scientific journal-type article, summarising the main project results and methodology used to achieve the project (*Please ensure you properly acknowledge OSCARS and the EU funding as indicated in our [communication kit](#)*);
- A poster (*template is available [here](#)*);
- 1 minute video to present the poster;
- A Self-Assessment (*accessible via the webform*);

All deliverables will be uploaded via [the webform here](#) in which you will find all instructions.

Step 2: Once the deliverables will be uploaded, the management team will receive an automatic email (a copy of the webform completed with all information). We will then forward the deliverables to the cluster representatives for them to review it.

Step 3: Once it's approved by the cluster representatives, the management team will send the deliverables to the Director of OSCARS project for final approval.

Step 4: Once it's approved, the management team will inform CNRS, they will have 14 days to issue the final payment to the Coordinator organisation.
